- Two categories – Classic margaritas and specialty margaritas.
- Bring at least one gallon premixed margaritas per entry.
- Bring enough salsa/pico so the judges can all get a taste.
- We will supply drink cooler jugs, tables, sample cups, chips for the salsa/pico category and voting boxes.
- Voting will be people’s choice

For judges, connoisseurs, and simply samplers, it’s even easier:

- \$10.00 admission gets you 10 votes.
- We encourage you to bring an appetizer to share. This will get you 5 extra votes
- Feel free to bring your own beverages.
- Ice and cups will be supplied. We will also have bottled water available.
- Bring a lawn chair.
